

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC WORKS
COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE
CITY OF HERRIN, ILLINOIS HELD IN THE
COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT CITY HALL ON
MONDAY, MARCH 5, 2018 AT 2:00 P.M.

Meeting called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those in attendance were Mayor Steve Frattini, Alderman David Shoemake, Alderman Sheila Ahlgren, Alderman Paul York, Alderman Marilyn Ruppel and Alderman Steve Miller, Police Chief Quinn Laird and City Clerk Shelly Huggins.

OLMC Request - Safety of the children is the biggest concern. They are asking for us to make a portion of N. 19th Street "No Parking" from Cherry to Monroe from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Alderman York has checked the area and there was no one parked there. We will extend Cherry Street one way to include 18th to 19th during school hours. N. 19th St. will be one way from Cherry to Monroe North bound and No Parking on East Side all hours. Also going to change W. Monroe from 18th to 19th to "No Parking" during school hours on North side(west bound).

Parking surfaced lot South of School on South side of Cherry St. - They would like to split the cost with us paying for material and they paying for labor. Material estimate is \$5,000.00. Mayor proposes that if they want the parking lot he would support us giving them the property or sell to them for a minimal charge and it will become their lot and they would pay for all improvements and maintenance. All in agreement with this portion.

They are asking us to expand the sidewalk on the South side of Monroe in front of the school. Mayor is concerned we have many sidewalks in town that need addressed as well. All in agreement that we do not have the resources to help with this project at this time.
